

















Key findings from the survey:

Here's an alternative version of the provided text:

- 1. A majority of students have expressed overall satisfaction with the timely completion of the syllabus (59.6%) and effective communication between teachers and students (62.9%).
- 2. Students have praised the teacher's dedication to teaching and fairness in evaluation. However, they suggested focusing more on underperforming students to build their confidence and improve their academic outcomes.
- 3. The teacher's preparedness, communication skills, application of effective teaching methods, and fairness in internal evaluations received high ratings in the survey.
- 4. Students also acknowledged (strongly agreed: 25.8%, agreed: 53.9%) the implementation of student-centric approaches, such as experiential learning, participative learning, and problem-solving techniques, which enhance their overall learning experience.

The SSS has identified some areas where the college, teachers, and departments could further improve the quality of education. These include:

- 1. Developing a system to identify students' strengths and weaknesses, providing appropriate challenges, and supporting them in overcoming their limitations.
- 2. Increasing the use of ICT tools in teaching and equipping laboratories with additional small instruments to cater to more students.

3. Expanding the library's collection by adding more books.
